

## There's A Fountain Flowing Free

**Zechariah 13:1**, “*In that day a fountain will be opened for the house of David and for the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for impurity.*”

**Zechariah 12:9-10**, “*In that day I will set about to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem. I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.*”

**Isaiah 53:5,7,12**, “*He was pierced for our rebellion, crushed for our sins. 7 He was led like a lamb to the slaughter. And as a sheep is silent before the shearers, he did not open his mouth. 12 He Himself bore the sins of many and interceded for the transgressors.*”

**John 1:29**, “*John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”*

**Hebrews 10:4**, “*It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.*”

**John 1:1,14**, “*In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us.*”

**Hebrews 2:14,17**, “*Since the children share in flesh and blood, Jesus Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless the devil who had the power of death.*”

**Colossians 1:20**, “*God made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross.*”

**8. The Blood Makes One at Peace with God**

**Hebrews 9:13-14**, “Under the old covenant, the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer could cleanse people’s bodies from ceremonial impurity.<sup>14</sup> Just think how much more the blood of Christ will purify our consciences from sinful deeds so that we can worship the living God. For by the power of the eternal Spirit, Christ offered himself to God as a perfect sacrifice for our sins.”

**Hebrews 9:18-22**, “Even the first covenant was put into effect with the blood of an animal.<sup>19</sup> After Moses had read each of God’s commandments to all the people, he took the blood of calves and goats, along with water, and sprinkled both the book of God’s law and all the people, using hyssop branches and scarlet wool.<sup>20</sup> Then he said, “This blood confirms the covenant God has made with you.”<sup>21</sup> And in the same way, he sprinkled blood on the Tabernacle and on everything used for worship.<sup>22</sup> In fact, according to the law of Moses, nearly everything was purified with blood. For without the shedding of blood, there is no forgiveness.”

**1 Peter 3:18,20-21**, “Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. Jesus never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.<sup>20</sup> God waited patiently for those who disobeyed God, while Noah was building his boat. Only eight people were saved from drowning in that terrible flood.<sup>21</sup> And that water is a picture of baptism, which now saves you, not by removing dirt from your body, but as a response to God from a clean conscience. Baptism is effective because of the resurrection of Jesus Christ.”

**Ephesians 2:8**, “For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God.”

**Luke 13:5**, “Unless you repent, you will all likewise perish (eternally).”

**Romans 10:9**, “If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”

**2 Thessalonians 1:7-8**, “Jesus will deal out retribution to those who do not know God and who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.”

**1 Corinthians 15:1-4**, “Now I make known to you the gospel, by which you are saved. I delivered to you as of first importance, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and He was raised on the third day.”

**Romans 6:3-5**, “Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?<sup>4</sup> Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.<sup>5</sup> For if we have become united with Him in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be in the likeness of His resurrection.”

**Acts 22:16**, “Now why do you delay? Get up and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on His name.”
